**The ATO Palm Editors & Associates**

This compilation is arranged according to the terms of service of the Editors in chronological order. Also included are the names of the Editor's associates, including all those listed in *The ATO Palm* masthead.

1. **Joseph R. Anderson**, *V.M.I.*, December, 1880-1882. Assistants: Charles M. Puckette, *Sewanee*; and Sylvanus Stokes, *Virginia*. Publisher: Theodore A. Johns, *Richmond*.
2. **Otis A. Glazebrook**, *V.M.I.*, 1883-1885. Assistants: Joseph R. Anderson, *V.M.I.*; Thomas F. Gailor, *Sewanee*; Walter Hines Page, *Duke*; H.H. Dinwiddie, *V.M.I.*; Francis H. Easby, *Pennsylvania*; and the High Council.
3. **Charles W. Baker**, *Gettysburg*, 1886. The High Council was instructed by the IX Congress to edit and publish *The Palm*. Baker is listed as Business Manager, but he performed most of the editorial work.
4. **Henry N. Felkel**, *Florida*, 1887-1888. Assistant Editors: Howard Lamar, *Auburn*; Irving Bacheller, *St. Lawrence*; Theodore D. Bratton, *Sewanee*; and J. Frank Wilkes, *North Carolina*. Business Manager: Charles W. Baker, *Gettysburg*.
5. **Walter T. Daniel**, *Virginia*, 1889-1890. During 1890 the magazine bore the caption, *Palm: The Panhellenic Magazine*.
6. **Otis A. Glazebrook**, *V.M.I.*, 1891-1892. Lee C. Bradley, *Birmingham-Southern*; Louis C. Ehle, *Cornell*; and John M. Morris, *Sewanee*.
7. **Louis C. Ehle**, *Cornell*, 1893-1901. Milo H. Massey, *Mercer*; James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; and Russel W. Taft, *Vermont*.
8. **N. Wiley Thomas**, *Pennsylvania*, February, 1902. Milo H. Massey, *Mercer*; James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; and Russel W. Taft, *Vermont*. This issue was published by N. Wiley Thomas as Chairman of the High Council after Ehle's resignation and before the election of a successor.
9. **Paul T. Cherrington** (later Cherington), *Pennsylvania*, April-December, 1902. James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; Russel W. Taft, *Vermont*; and John T. Montgomery, *Rose*.
10. **D. Stanley Briggs**, *St. Lawrence*, 1903-March, 1904. James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; and John T. Montgomery, *Rose*.
11. **Hendree P. Simpson**, *Alabama*, June, 1904-June, 1905. James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; John T. Montgomery, *Rose*; and Claude T. Reno, *Muhlenberg*.
12. **Claude T. Reno**, *Muhlenberg*, September, 1905-1917. Associate Editors: Hendree P. Simpson, *Alabama*; Alfred S. Hartzell, *Muhlenberg*; Theodore H. Jones, *Wisconsin*; Hebert L. Blankenburg, *Wisconsin*; Frank W. Scott, *Illinois*; and William C. Smiley, *Minnesota*. Assistant Publisher, Harvey L. Reno, *Muhlenberg*.
13. **Frank W. Scott**, *Illinois*, 1917-1950. Managing Editors: Charles L. Allen, *North Dakota*, May, 1928-May 1932; Stewart D. Daniels, *Illinois*, May, 1932-May, 1935 (editing several issues when WWII conditions make editorial assistance

unavailable); Thomas S. Bird, *Chicago*, 1939-1942 (in reality had discharged that responsibility since 1937), having served as Assistant Editor, 1935-1939; William G. Key, *Mercer*, March, 1943; Tom Means, *Charleston*, 1943-1944; and Harry L. Bird, *Chicago*, 1945-1950. Associate Editors: Harvey L. Reno, *Muhlenberg*, 1925 (editing "The Greek World" department until 1953); William C. Smiley, *Minnesota*, Harry F. Harrington, *Wooster*, and Walter Ben Hare, *Emory*, served until 1926; and C.L.S. Raby, *Gettysburg*, served until 1930. Business Manager: Stewart D. Daniels, 1926-1965. The June 1937 issue was published as a membership directory.

14. **Harry L. Bird**, *Chicago*, 1950-March 1970. Managing Editors: Robert J. Simonds, *Illinois*, 1950-1959, having served as Associate Editor, 1947-1950; Leland J. Arney, *Missouri*, March-June 1960; William D. Krahling, *Mount Union*, 1968-1970, having served as Associate Editor, September, 1960-1968. Associate Editors: Harvey L. Reno, *Muhlenberg*, 1925 (editing "The Greek World" department until 1953.) Art Editors at varying times between 1945-1959: Dick Allen, *Illinois*; H. Vincent Allen, *Illinois*; and Robert E. Vogele, *Illinois*. Business Managers: Stewart D. Daniels, *Illinois*, 1926-1965; and Norman E. Ritchie, *Syracuse*, 1966-1975.
15. **William D. Krahling**, *Mount Union*, May, 1970-Fall, 1985. Design Consultant: Robert E. Vogele, *Illinois*. Design Assistants: Kerry Grady, 1982-1983; Ted Stoik, 1984-1985; and Dana Arnett, 1985. Editorial Assistants: Jan Grimes, 1974; Annette Buntin Jackson, 1975; Marcia Harrington, 1976-1978; Nina Stanberry, 1978-1979; Kathy Brown, 1979-1980; Barbara Duncan, 1980; Alison Brown, 1980; Pat Bastion, 1980-1982; Lesli Pearson Underwood, 1982-1985; and Betsy Hepp, 1985. Business Managers: Norman E. Ritchie, *Syracuse*, 1966-1975; William A. Parise, *New Mexico*, 1977; Stephen R. Siders, *Purdue*, 1977-1987. Note: the date of issue publication was changed from month to season with the Winter 1982 issue.
16. **Robert E. Vogele**, *Illinois*, Winter, 1985-1993. Associate Editors: Steve A. Glaser, *Millikin*, 1986-1990; and John R. Melchi, *Illinois*, 1992-1994. Editorial Assistants: Betsy Hepp, 1985-1986; and Scheri Baumgardner, 1986. Director of Communication: Wynn R. Smiley, *Purdue*, 1991-1993. Editorial Consultant: Denise Barker, 1986. Contributing Editors: Kevin King, 1987; and Greg Walsh, 1987. Illustrator: Ray Fredericks, 1987. Business Managers: Stephen R. Siders, *Purdue*, 1977-1987; and Mark O. Thorsby, *Albion*, 1987-1994. Note: 1) The page size was enlarged from its basic 8 ½ X 11 inches to the tabloid 11 X 17 inches with the Summer 1986 issue, returning to 8 ½ X 11 inches with the Fall 1993 issue; 2) While *The Palm* was retained as the official name, alternate names for a time were most prominent on the cover: *ATO Today* (Fall, 1986); *The ATO Journal* (Winter 1986); *ATO Inquirer* (Spring 1987); *Varsity* (Summer 1987); and *ATO Alive* (Fall 1987, Winter 1987, Spring 1988, Fall 1988, Spring 1989 and Fall 1989); and 3) Quarterly publication was discontinued in 1988 in favor of a flexible schedule of generally two issues a year.
